PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS:

The project proposes to remove rock from outcroppings along ID-75 for use as buttressing to stabilize an earthen slide south of the summit. The work lies between mileposts 153 and 162, approximately four miles on each side of Galena Summit. Construction will impact traffic and recreational opportunities for approximately 12 to 18 months.
