



US-95 & ID-53 Interchange, Garwood Road, UPRR Bridge & Frontage Roads

March 2020



OVERVIEW

The Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) is continuing to reconfigure several roadways near the US-95 junctions with ID-53 and Garwood Road north of Hayden. This project is part of a larger vision to improve traffic flow and enhance safety on a local and regional level for present and future users along US-95 between Garwood Road and Sagle. Construction started in spring 2019 and is anticipated to be complete by the end of 2021.

SCOPE & SCHEDULE

In 2019, the key project elements included, constructing foundation structures for both the ID-53 interchange and the new railroad bridge, widening ID-53 between US-95 and Ramsey Road, completing significant earthwork for the new ID-53 alignment, and adding a temporary signal at ID-53 and Ramsey Road.


The remaining project scope and anticipated schedule are as follows:

Spring 2020 through Fall 2020

- Finish work on the ID-53 interchange and railroad bridge.
- Extend a frontage road (Pope Road) to the east of US-95 to connect the new ID-53 interchange and Garwood Road overpass.

Fall 2020 through Fall 2021

- Construct a roundabout at ID-53 and Government Way.
- Construct an overpass at Garwood Road that will eliminate direct access to US-95.



TRAFFIC IMPACTS

The current detour around ID-53 west of US-95 will remain in place as the ID-53 interchange and railroad bridge are being constructed. Once these two elements, along with the eastside frontage road (Pope Road) are open, access to US-95 from Garwood Road will be eliminated. Motorists will then use the ID-53 interchange to access US-95, either via Pope Road on the east side or Old Highway 95 on the west side.
